ATTENTION GIRLS SURF SAFARI:

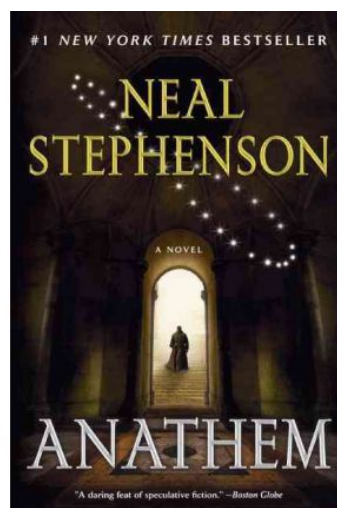
