The Hamlet Prize

Contribution to Oxley College Sport Award

Awarded to a Year 12 student to recognise their valuable and loyal contribution to College sporting teams.

Cultural Award

Awarded to a Year 12 student who has contributed most in the area of Art, Drama, Music and Oratory pursuits.

David Hoskins Memorial Music Award

Awarded to the best Year 12 musician at the College.

The P & F Prize

Awarded on behalf of the Oxley Parents & Friends Association to a Year 12 student who has shown a unique and exemplary contribution to the life of the College.

The Good Citizenship Award

Awarded to a Year 12 student who has exemplified a spirit of committed contribution to the Oxley community over a sustained period of time.

The David Wright All Rounder Award

Awarded to a Year 12 student who has consistently achieved across a range of academic, sporting and service activities while maintaining a positive attitude and a sense of pride in our College.

The Helmut Schaefer Award for Leadership

Awarded to a Year 12 student, who is neither a House nor School Captain. They have demonstrated excellent leadership and upheld the values of leadership across a range of academic and co-curricular activities.

The Oxley Award

This is the premier Award of the College. It is awarded to a Year 12 student who, in the judgement of the Awards Committee, has in all four fields: academic, cultural, leadership and sport, achieved the best overall performance.
