<p>Students will use the normal timetable to provide set zones of learning time across the two days for direct instruction (synchronous) lessons.</p> <p>A Weekly Learning Cycle, sent by email each Monday morning will provide direction for students. It will outline the Learning Intention and the Success Criteria for the series of lessons. This will guide student learning throughout the week and provide opportunity for ongoing feedback on progression.</p> <p>Teachers will use Zoom to clarify instructions and check for student understanding of the set work. Our learning management system, Canvas, will continue to be the repository of information, resources and feedback.</p>	<p>Wednesday at Oxley College will be the day where timetabled learning continues, enhanced with an additional overlay of connection, collaboration and consultation to support student wellbeing.</p> <p>Students will continue to work through their learning cycle however no new instructions from teachers will be delivered on this day. This will provide time to work, revise, plan and prepare for the submission of any portfolio work, projects and assignments.</p> <p>On this day Heads of House, our Counsellor and the Learning Engagement staff will be available at set times to facilitate ongoing connection and consultation with students and parents.</p> <p>There will be also be opportunities for House and College activities with an additional aim to have an afternoon free of screens and increased physical activity.</p>	<p>Students will follow their normal timetable with a focus on increased opportunities for feedback.</p> <p>Students will provide evidence of their learning in a variety of forms. This may include portfolio and journal pieces, project and performance work. These may also be the days where quizzes and assessments occur.</p> <p>Throughout the weeks, Cornerstone and Year 7 Learning2Learn lessons will be used to provide discussion, reflection and journaling time. All students will be encouraged to read widely and to pursue a Personal Interest Project that explores an area of passion and curiosity. Year 9 and 10 students are already working on this, Year 7 and 8 will also have the opportunity if interested.</p>
