



Oxley College Junior School Swimming Carnival 2023

Dear Parents,

The Oxley College Junior School Swimming Carnival will be held **on Thursday 16 February** at the Bowral Swimming Centre.

Students in Years 3 - 6 will be transported to and from the Bowral Swimming Centre by bus departing at 9.00am and returning to the College by 2.45pm. Please discuss participation with your child prior to the Carnival and indicate their level of involvement on the Permission Form via the link [here](#) before Wednesday 8 February.

Students in Kindergarten, Year 1 and Year 2 will remain at school on this day. A Splash & Dash Swimming Event will be held on Thursday 23 February with communication to follow.

Novelty events and non-competitive 25m races have been included in the programme to enable all students in the Junior School to compete at the Carnival.

If you wish to collect your child at the conclusion of the Carnival instead of your child travelling back to the College on the bus, please ensure you complete the relevant section on the jot form link above.

Please note that the students will not be allowed to purchase anything from the Canteen at the pool and we ask that parents please do not act as facilitators in purchasing for the students. Students will need to provide all their own food and drink for the day. A supply of small nutritional snacks is ideal as are a couple of water bottles.

Students who are selected to represent Oxley at the IPSHA Carnival will receive permission notes following the Oxley Carnival.

Swimming Carnival Information

- Age – the age the student has turned or will turn this calendar year.
- All races to be swum according to the Rules of Swimming Australia.
- The Oxley College Sports Departments decision will be final.
- There will be no pre-entry for events. Students can decide their events and will be marshalled on the day.
- What age group do I compete in?
 - The age group you compete in is the age you will be on 31 December 2023.
 - Eg. if you turn nine this year (before 31.12.23) you swim in the 9 years races.
 - No swimmers may swim up or down an age group.
- Which Divisional Age Group do I race in?
 - Juniors – 8, 9 & 10 years.
 - Senior – 11, 12 & 13 years or 12 & 13 years when there is an 11 years event.
- A student who swims in a 50m event may not swim in the equivalent 25m event.
- The 25m events for freestyle, breaststroke and backstroke will take place at the same time as the 50m events of the same stroke. The 25m events will be swum in the 25m pool and the 50m events will be swum in the 50m pool.
- 25m events are open to all Year 3 – Year 6 students.
- Final placings will be calculated on TIME, excluding participation events.
- 50m freestyle races will be raced in heats. The fastest six competitors will then qualify for a final. If there are six or less competitors in a 50m freestyle event, this will be raced as a final. All other strokes will be timed as finals. Rankings will be calculated after all races have been completed. Championship points and representative selection will be determined from the results of the finals.
- The goal for each student is to participate in at least **one event**
 - *All students are expected to try their best and respect the environment. If a student is disrupting the carnival by not making a serious attempt during their event (eg. dog paddling, not doing the correct stroke etc.) they will be removed from the event.*
 - **EVERY STUDENT THAT SWIMS WILL RECEIVE A POINT FOR THEIR HOUSE**
- The announcer will call events as per the programme.
- Students are not allowed to wear Zinc, bring crepe paper or have glass bottles in the venue.
- Age Championships will be calculated based on all events across the Carnival.
- Students can compete in as many events as they wish.
- If a student is away on the day that an event is programmed for any reason other than a school endorsed activity, the student cannot be timed at an earlier or later date.
- There will be awards for the following; Girls and Boys Junior, Girls and Boys 11 years and Girls and Boys Senior Age Champion and Runner-up Age Champions.

General Information

- The event will be held on **Thursday 16 February 2023** at the **Bowral Swimming Centre**. The Swimming Carnival is a significant College event that contributes to House and School Spirit across the years. The aim of the event is to promote house spirit, encourage participation and celebrate the swimming ability of our students.
- All students are required to be at the College **no later than 8.30am**.
- Buses will transport all students to and from Bowral Swimming Centre.
- **A Medical Certificate is required if your child cannot attend. Absences need to be emailed to – JuniorStudentServices@oxley.nsw.edu.au by 9.00am.**
- Buses will return to the College at approximately 2.45pm (dependent on traffic) at the completion of the Carnival.

Uniform

- **Swimmers** – Oxley College or plain Navy Swimmers are to be worn in the pool. These can be worn underneath their sports uniform. Goggles are encouraged to be worn for all races and should not be shared.
- All students competing must wear a House swimming cap. These will be supplied on the day.
- **Dress – Students must wear their House Shirt** with PE sports shorts and their school sports cap.
- Students are expected to bring their Sports Tracksuit as wet weather clothing (if needed).
- Students would benefit by packing two towels to use during the day.

Food and Drink

- Students will not be allowed to purchase anything from the Canteen at the pool and we ask that parents please do not act as facilitators in purchasing for the students.
- Students will need to provide all their own food and drink for the day. A supply of small nutritional snacks is ideal as are a couple of water bottles.
- Students should drink plenty of water throughout the day, particularly prior to and post competing in events. **Please note: no glass bottles or containers are to be brought to the venue under any circumstances.**

Transport Information

- All students will be transported to and from the Bowral Swimming Centre by bus departing at 9.00am and returning to the College by 2.45pm.
- If you wish to collect your child at the conclusion of the Carnival instead of your child travelling back to the College by bus, please ensure you complete the relevant section on the jot form link.
- **Please Note** - If a student **misses** the bus, it is an expectation and responsibility of the parent to drive the student to Bowral Swimming Centre. There will be no provisions for students to remain at school.
