**Student Absence** - you will receive a notification at the start of the day alerting you to the absence. If you are aware of your child being away at this stage, please don't do anything. If you were not aware of their absence, please contact Student Services. We will continue to mark the roll throughout the day and at the end of the school day send you another notification, could you please follow the prompts and fill out the details then?

**Incursion/Excursions** – these are often a two-step process where you will need to give permission and click the payID link to pay for the excursion, we ask that both steps are completed before the student attends the event.
